

## **COALITION TO END TOBACCO TARGETING**

We the undersigned, express our support for the City of Columbus enacting legislation to end the sale of flavored tobacco products in our city. While we have witnessed the ravages of all tobacco, flavored tobacco products pose a unique threat to the health of our residents.

As the only flavored cigarette left on the market, menthol cigarettes have a devastating impact on youth initiation of tobacco use and are a significant cause of health disparities and preventable death in the Black community. The science is clear: Because menthol reduces the harshness of tobacco, it makes it easier to start using tobacco products, can lead to increased nicotine addiction, and makes it harder for people to quit.

For decades, tobacco companies have targeted specific communities with marketing for menthol cigarettes, especially Black communities. As a result, the percentage of Black smokers using menthol has increased from 10% in the 1950s to 85% today. This is the effect of predatory targeting, not preference. Meanwhile, tobacco claims approximately 45,000 Black lives each year, making it the leading cause of preventable death in the Black community.

The tobacco industry knows that 95% of adult smokers start by age 21. They have a long history of targeting kids with flavored products. There are more than 15,500 unique e-cigarette flavors and more than 250 unique flavors of cigars on the market – flavors such as bubblegum, cherry dynamite, popcorn and blueberry ice. These flavored tobacco products are addicting a new generation of kids to nicotine and reversing the decades-long progress in reducing youth tobacco use.

The City of Columbus has a proud history of taking action in support of public health. Such leadership is needed now. According to the 2019 Ohio Youth Tobacco Survey, nearly one in four high school students and nearly 13% of middle school students have used a flavored tobacco product. In Franklin County, Columbus Public Health has seen an 8% increase in smoking rates for African American adults. Ending the sale of flavored tobacco in Columbus will not solve all the health problems caused by tobacco use, but it will significantly reduce the number of people who become addicted to nicotine in the first place.

Now is the time to act, and now is the time to lead. Please protect our residents from the predatory tactics of the tobacco industry by ending the sale of flavored tobacco in Columbus.
